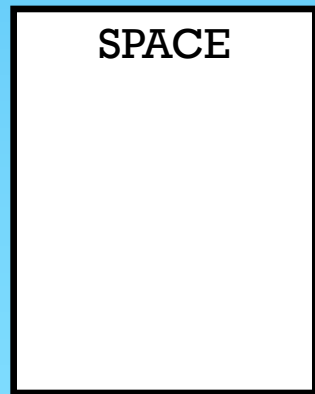

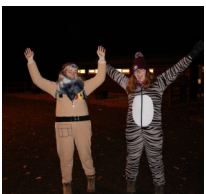

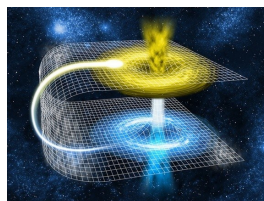
## THE LATEST IN JUMPSUIT FASHION
