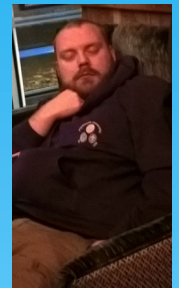
Hall of Shame

Lauren from Southampton asks "Does he have eyebrows?"



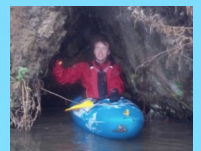
Bradley asleep

Niall from Bangor, on their kayaking trip, tipped very slowly into the water while attempting to score a sideways goal while playing canoe polo.

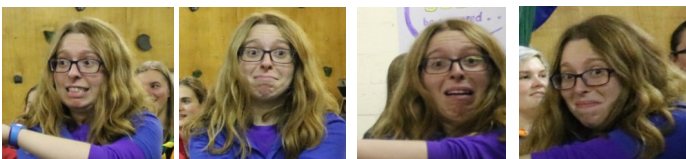
