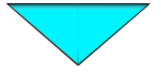

We're going to the lake district for a between Christmas and New Year get away. We've also got marathon service challenge for nearly 100 14+ year olds

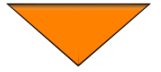

As a group, there was nothing exciting, but had a few members out in Iceland for the World Scout Moot, and others running international camps here in the UK.

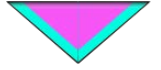

We're also looking into any other large scale events we can take part in for the year ahead, potentially including IOW Revolution and Forest Evasion in the spring.

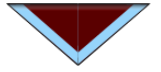
